BIOGRAPHY JUDITH BARIBEAU

Judith Baribeau has been performing on the small and big screen for about 15 years now. Fully bilingual, she has appeared on multiple popular TV shows, such as The Disappearance (CTV / NBC Universal Studios), 21 Thunder (CBC / Netflix), District 31 (Radio-Canada), Au secours de Béatrice (TVA), as well as in the made-for-television films Mean Queen and Deadly Hope (Incendo). In 2013, she was nominated for a Gémeaux award for Best Supporting Actress in a comedy series, for her role in Mauvais Karma (Radio-Canada).

On the big screen, Judith has worked with celebrated directors Kim Nguyen (in Le marais), Philippe Falardeau (in Oscar-nominated Monsieur Lazhar), John Duigan (in Head In The Clouds) and Alexis Durand-Brault (in La petite reine).

More recently, Judith was Françoise in Isla Blanca, Jeanne Leblanc's poignant first feature. The film was presented in festivals around the world.

In the summer of 2018, Judith had the pleasure of joining forces again with director Jeanne Leblanc in the feature film Les nôtres (Slykid & Skykid). She played Chantale Grégoire, a helpless mother entangled in her community's crisis. Les nôtres is also Judith's debut as a screenwriter of feature films – she co-wrote Les nôtres with Jeanne Leblanc. Judith is now working on two more feature film scripts.

On the stage, Judith played Virginia, in The Secret Annex, by Alix Sober, at the Segal Center in Montreal. She also lends her voice to many commercials and video games.
