She appears on CBC in *Murdoch Mysteries*, on Bell Media in *Rencontres The Series* and in short films such as *Olivia*, which gained recognition in multiple festivals across the world. She recently had the immense privilege to work under the direction of Donna Feore and composer Jonathan Monroe in a new production of the Segal Centre, *The Hockey Sweater: A Musical*. She was recently part of a workshop and performance of the play *La Pierre*, directed by Joël Beddows and presented by Le Groupe de La Veillée.
