BIOGRAPHY MARC-ANDRÉ BRUNET

Marc-André Brunet is an actor and a screenwriter from Montreal. On television he has been seen in 5e Rang, District 31, Victor Lessard, 19-2, Yamaska and Toute la Vérité. On the big screen, he appeared in Le Rire et Les manèges humains and Ceux qui font les révolutions [...]. He often works as a voice over actor and can be heard in many movies, television series, commercials and video games.

He has played in various plays such as Pépo Citrouille, Les Atrides, Le projet Laramie, Couple: l'expérience and Les indiscretions publiques. He works on a regular basis with companies such as Théâtre Parminou, Rencontre Théâtre Ados, Théâtre Bluff and Réseau ArtHist. Since 2013, he is the artistic director of Théâtre Tombé du Ciel a company he founded that produces plays for teens. Lately, he has written and produced Temps Zéro, which was presented at the Théâtre Denise-Pelletier in 2018. He has also written and directed the play Les Volk: famille légendaire, which was presented, on tour in the province of Quebec, over 150 times between 2010 et 2019.

Marc-André is also one of the screenwriters on Alix et les Merveilleux, a kids television show produced by Avanti Groupe and aired on ICI Radio-Canada télé and Télé-Québec. He graduated from l'Option-Théâtre du Collège Lionel-Groulx in 2008 and from l'École Nationale de l'Humour in 2018.
